

# © Chomsky



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## Materials Needed:

- \* Crochet hook (as shown: US E , 3.5mm)
- \* Dark Brown felt (for the feet)
- \* Black felt (for mouth)
- \* White felt (for tooth)
- \* Embroidery thread (as shown: black)
- \* Stuffing (polyfiber fill)
- \* Craft glue
- \* Hot glue gun & glue
- \* Tapestry/sewing needles (for weaving in ends and closing seams)
- \* Worsted Weight yarn in 3 colors.  
(as shown: KnitPicks Wool of the Andes in colors Pumpkin, Chestnut and Cloud)

## Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- st = stitch
- inv dec = invisible decrease
- MC = Main Color (the color of the body)
- CC = Complimentary color (the color of the arms)
- TC = Tertiary color (the color of the horn)

## Important Notes:

- \* Please read the pattern notes and the instructions prior to starting so that you can ensure that you understand what is expected before you get to the end of the row.
- \* This pattern is moderately difficult for beginners because you will be crocheting with a small number of stitches.
- \* Take breaks if you feel fatigue or cramping in your hands.
- \* For the entire pattern, you will not be ending the rows but will continue in a spiral.

## Body:

- R1 Using the magic circle, make 6 scs [6 sts]
- R2 (2 sc in next st) 6 times [12 sts]
- R3 (1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 6 times [18 sts]
- R4 (1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st) 6 times [24 sts]
- R5 (2 sc in next sts, 1 sc in next 3 sts) 6 times [30 sts]
- R6 (1 sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times [33 sts]
- R7 (1 sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts) 3 times [36 sts]
- R8-R20 sc in each st around [36 sts]

\* Use a piece of waste yarn to mark the beginning of the row.  
Finish off. Leave a long tail for closing later.

## Bottom:

- R1 Using the magic circle, make 6 scs [6 sts]  
R2 (2 sc in next st) 6 times [12 sts]  
R3 (1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 6 times [18 sts]  
R4 (1 sc in next st, 2sc in next st, 1 sc in next st) 6 times [24 sts]  
R5 (2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts) 6 times [30 sts]  
R6 (1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts) 6 times [36 sts]  
Finish off. Close the circle to form smooth edge and weave in end.



## Arms (Make 2):

- R1 Using the magic circle, make 6 scs [6 sts]  
R2 (2 sc in next st) 6 times [12 sts]  
R3-R5 1 sc in each sts around [12 sts]  
R6 (1 inv dec across 2 sts, 1 sc in next 4 sts) 2 times [10 sts]  
R7 1 sc in each st around [10 sts]  
R8 (1 sc in next 3 sts, 1 inv dec across 2 sts) 2 times [8 sts]  
R9 1 sc in each st around [8 sts]

Finish off leaving a tail for attaching later. Stuff very lightly using the back of a pen to help push some polyfil into the round portion of the hand. Do not over stuff.

**\* Special Note \*** I like to make both of my puffs at the same time (so I don't stuff one arm more than another later). They don't have to be perfect, but it's easier to see the differences before you add the stuffing to the arm/hand.



## Horn:

- R1 Leaving a tail (for attaching later), loosely ch 7.  
1 sc in the back hump of each ch, closing the loop to make a circle/tube.  
R2-R3 sc in each sts [7 sts]  
R4 1 inv dec across 2 sts, 1 sc in next 3 sts, 1 inv dec across 2 sts [5 sts]  
R5 1 sc in next st, 1 inv dec across 2 sts, 1 sc in next st [4 sts]  
Finish off leaving a small tail. Thread needle and go through the outer loop of each st. Pull tight. Weave in end.

## Finishing:

- \* Attach the horn on rows 7 and 8, being careful not to flatten the horn as you're attaching (keeping it round).
- \* Flatten the top of the arm and attach the arms to the side of the body. You want the arms to rest downward.
- \* Embroider on the eyes with black embroidery thread.
- \* Paying close attention to the right and wrong side of the bottom, begin attaching the bottom with the right side facing out.
  - Leaving about an 8-10 stitch opening, begin stuffing the body.
  - Because of Chomsky's shape, be careful not to over-stuff his body or he will not sit flat on the bottom.
  - Finish closing the bottom and weave in end.
- \* Cut a black circle out of felt.
  - Cut a small white square out of felt.
  - Using craft glue, attach the tooth to the edge of the black circle and trim corners.
- \* Attach the mouth to the body using a hot glue gun.
- \* Cut 2 feet from dark brown felt.
  - Glue along the zigzag lines and place along the bottom of Chomsky with the tips sticking out.



\* Note \* Do not use this as a template, it is only here to show you the shape of the feet and where to place glue.
